

The Stations of the Cross (both those in the cypress frames and those in the windows) were painted by Jerome Hill, of St. Paul Minnesota, the nephew of the church's donor and a noted artist. The windows are designed with a fish scale motif.

Station 8 – Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem.



Station 9 – Jesus falls a third time.



Station 10 – Jesus clothes are taken away.



Station 11 – Jesus is nailed to the cross.



Station 12 – Jesus dies on the cross.



Station 13 – The body of Jesus is taken down from the cross.



Station 14 – Jesus is laid in the tomb.
